## The TAVAC Composers Competition

### Composer's Information (CI)

1. The composition is for one to five instruments (instrumental only, no voice). The duration of the piece is from 1 min. 30s to 5 minutes. The composition is intended for acoustic instruments. Entry requires a non-exclusive royalty-free copyright licence to be provided to the event organiser. There are no restrictions of age, qualification or experience. Anyone who is resident in NZ, or who is living overseas and has NZ citizenship is elligible. It will possibly be performed in front of a live audience at the next Tauranga Amateur Variety Concert. The piece must have been composed within 1 year of the date the competition entries opened. Pieces can not have been awarded a placing in another competition (at the time the piece is entered in the TAVAC competition). The first page of the manuscript will be published on the TAVAC website.

### 2. Style

In general please try to choose pieces which are lighter in nature, reasonably cheerful or melodious and have a wide audience appeal. The genre of the composition piece is at the discretion of the musician, whether Jazz, or Baroque etc. There are some marks allocated to "Cheerfulness". However, if you wish to enter a funeral dirge, it is possible, but in the "Cheerfulness" marking category (see marking schedule downloadable at <a href="https://www.tavac.co.nz">www.tavac.co.nz</a>), fewer marks will be achieved. The composition should have elements of melody, harmony and rhythmn, which most musical compositions have. Again if one component is missing, fewer marks will be achieved.

#### 3. Skill level

The composition must at minimum be of grade-3 ABRSM exam level or equivalent and a maximum of grade-8. The notation should not be unreasonably complex.

- 4. The piece must be submitted as a music score in jpg or pdf format, and as a recording. Please provide a copy of the music score without your name on it, so that the pieces may be judged anonymously. The recording maybe synthesised by computer (including by midi) or be of a live performance. These files should be sent via email. Most audio format types will be accepted (but no midi files please). Cell phone microphone recordings are acceptable. We will contact you in the rare circumstance that your audio file can not be played.
- 5. Judging. All entries will be anonymized by the organiser. Three unremunerated judges will assess the entries. The event organiser will not participate in judging the entries. It is not permitted for judges to receive entries, until they have been selected as judges. Judges individually will score each entry. They will then confer about the merits of the winners, and endeavour to reach consensus. If one of the judges disagrees strongly with 2 judges, this judge may choose to award a joint tie, but usually two judges out of three would result in a single place giving. If all 3 judges disagree, the name of two joint winners will be drawn from a hat containing the three nominations, and the remaining candidate will be selected for the next lowest placing. The winning pieces are open to inspection by qualified music teachers, or degree qualified music graduates.
- 6. If the entries are considered of insufficient standard, or there are less than or equal to 5 entries, TAVAC may choose to return the non-exclusive copyright licence to the participating composers, and cancel the competition.
- 7. Eligibility. Judges and their immediate family or partners are not permitted to enter. Those who participate in organising TAVAC events may enter the composers competition. However, they are not eligible for prizes, other than that they are eligible to receive a ranking of "Honorary tie for 1st, 2nd or 3rd place".
- 8. Please see the website for entry date, closing date. Correspondence will not be entered into regarding results, unless it is regarding miscommunication or an administrative mistake. Please direct all correspondence to the organiser(s).
- 9. The winner will receive \$800, 2nd place \$300 and 3rd \$150. In case of a joint tie being awarded e.g. 1st place tie, \$400 each would be awarded. Results will be notified within 7 weeks of the entry closing date.
- 10. Notification of prizes will be done by email. The entrant to the competition must send bank account details by email to concert@tavac.co.nz within 30 days of prize notification, or the prize will be forfeighted. Please check you receive a confirmation email indicating (a) that your bank account details have been received, and (b) date payment is to be expected. Please notify the organiser when the prize money has been received.
